- a. License Period: Two years, further extendable for One year.
- b. Minimum Reserve License Fee (MRLF) of Rs. 61,150/- per month
- c. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD): Rs. 1,00,000/-
- d. Eligibility Criteria:
 - i. The bidder should be any Sole Proprietor/Partnership firm, a Company registered in India, and must be legally competent and financially sound.
 - ii. Bidder having similar type of business atleast from last (2) years in Airports/Shopping Malls/Railway Stations, Ferry/Ships Terminals, Bus Terminus etc. Relevant proof to be submitted.
 - iii. The Bidding Company must have EPF Registration / licence in its own name, if applicable. Copy of the said Registration / License should be a part of Submission.
- e. Any party either a firm or an individual falling under the following categories is not eligible:
 - i. De-barred / black listed by CBI/MADC/MIL/AAI or Undertakings / Departments like; Railway, Defence, or any other Department of Govt. of India, State Govt. A declaration to this effect is also to be submitted along with the tender documents.
 - ii. Parties either an individual or a business establishment, who has been ordered by a Court of Law to pay the outstanding dues of MADC/ MIL /AAI at any of the airports as a whole and has not paid such dues shall also not be eligible for the tender.
 - iii. The parties having undisputed dues (including Interest on delayed payments) exceeding one month " License fee" in each contract at Airport/s managed by MIL/ AAI).
